About Round Up!

In keeping with its Corporate Citizenship Policy, Lewis Media Inc. has launched the customer charitable contribution Round Up Program for 2006. The objective of the Round Up program is to encourage our customers to help us support three selected community organizations. Two organizations (WEEF and Sky's the Limit) have been selected for ongoing support, while the third organization to receive support (Argus Residence for Young People – for 2006) is voted on annually by Lewis Media staff. Participating Round Up customers are also welcome to submit organizations to be considered for the annual spot in the program in future years.

Recipient Organizations



WEEF – Waterloo Engineering Endowment Foundation (Ongoing)

The Waterloo Engineering Endowment Foundation (WEEF) was started in 1990 by two University of Waterloo (UW) engineering students – Avi Belinsky and John Vellinga – and has since grown to become the largest student-run endowment fund in Canada. The single goal of WEEF is to benefit undergraduate engineering at UW either through funding departmental proposals such as improvements to equipment, industry-standard software and study materials, or by funding UW student teams and initiatives such as the UW Alternative Fuels Team, the solar car race team, the local chapter of Engineers Without Borders or the Solar Technology Education Project. Although it is an endowment fund, WEEF depends on donations from students, alumni and others in order to continue to grow.



Sky's the Limit (Ongoing)

This Toronto based organization provides under-resourced students with the tools and resources they need to pursue the infinite opportunities and possibilities available to them online. Sky's the Limit improves the students' overall computer skills while developing their essential workplace skills. At the same time, the organization reduces technological waste by diverting used computers from landfill sites. By providing these computers (refurbished) to under-resourced students, Sky's the Limit helps protect the environment from a growing stream of technological waste, while bridging the digital divide between Canada's have and have-nots.

Argus Residence for Young People (Annual 2006)

The Argus Residence provides emergency shelter for homeless youth between the ages of 16-24 in Cambridge, Ontario. This shelter provides immediate services combined with a comprehensive life skill acquisition program that, with the support of community partners, will prepare young people for independent living or if feasible, a safe and healthy return home.

How Round Up Works

Lewis Media customers have the opportunity to “round-up” any of their Lewis Media invoices (after inclusion of all taxes – eg. \$1,000 plus GST = \$1,070 rounded up to \$1,100). The rounded up amount (\$30 in the example) is donated in full to one or more of the organizations described above. Donations will be forwarded by Lewis Media Inc. to the selected organization(s) within 10 business days of funds clearance. A charitable donation receipt (minimum \$10 donation) will be issued by the recipient organization(s) directly to the customer.
